Your 9 Day Tour Includes:

- Roundtrip airfare from Detroit Metro Airport to Shannon and return from Dublin to Detroit
- (7) nights accommodations: (1) night in Westport; (1) night Belmullet; (2) nights in Killarney; (1) night in Cork and (2) nights in Dublin
- (10) meals: daily full Irish breakfast and (4) dinners, including a Farewell Dinner
- Roundtrip airport transfers in Ireland and luxury coach for all sightseeing and touring
- Arrangement and contact with the Cork Gardia Social Club. Note that the police in Ireland are called the Garda Siochana (Guardians of the Peace)
- Arrangements for Mass
- Entrances and/or visits to Ballintubber Abbey, Cliffs of Moher, Blarney Castle, Waterford Crystal Factory, Trinity College, Book of Kells, Dublin's National Garda (Police) Museum, and the Guinness Storehouse

Oct. 16, Tuesday: Overnight transatlantic flight from Detroit to Shannon, Ireland.
Oct. 17, Wednesday: Upon arrival in Shannon, you are met with a “cead mile failte”(a hundred thousand welcomes) by your Irish tour escort. Depart to Galway and visit this beautiful City of the Bay. Depending on flight times have some free time in Galway before continuing to the town of Westport. Cocktail reception and Welcome dinner in your hotel. Overnight Westport (D)
Oct. 18, Thursday: This morning *celebrate Mass at St. Mary’s* and a late morning departure before travelling north along Clew Bay to Belmullet. Stop for lunch at the Heritage Center before driving on to historic lighthouse for a visit, then returning to Belmullet for check-in at Broadhaven Hotel. Overnight in Belmullet (B)
Oct. 19, Friday: Depart Belmullet and visit Ballintubber Abbey. Next, travel along Galway Bay through the Burren region to the majestic Cliffs of Moher, which rise 600 feet above the Atlantic Ocean. From here go to Lahinch with free time and maybe lunch on your own in O’Loony’s pub on the beachfront. Continue along the Atlantic Coast to Kilrush and take the ferry across the Shannon River toward the town of Killarney for dinner at you hotel. Overnight Killarney (B,D)
Oct. 20, Saturday: There are many options today! You may want to take the famous “Ring of Kerry Tour” (no extra cost) to see some of the most spectacular scenery Ireland has to offer which will amaze you with it’s sheer rugged beauty and stunning views over Dingle Bay. Or, for an **extra cost**, you may prefer to select from the following: **Golf:** *Three courses, Mahony’s Point, Killeen or Lackabane.* **Fishing:** *On the Lakes of Killarney.* **Trekking:** *Pony trekking near the National Park.* **Cycling:** *Rent a bike and cycle along the Lakes of Killarney through the National Park.* (Prices for these options will be announced later.) Tonight good pub food is your option with free time in the town of Killarney. Overnight Killarney (B)
Oct. 21, Sunday: *Celebrate Mass in the Franciscan Friary* before departing Killarney travelling east to the village of Blarney. Time here to visit Blarney Castle and maybe kiss its famous Blarney Stone, which is believed to bestow the gift of eloquence on anybody who kisses it!Time then for shopping in the renowned Blarney Woollen Mills. Then check in at your hotel in Cork. Dinner this evening in the **Cork Garda Social Club in the city run by the Gardaian in the city. We may be joined by some Garda members and have a local Superintendent of the Garda speak at the gathering.** (The police in Ireland are called Garda Siochana (Guardians of the Peace). Overnight in Cork. (B,D)
Oct. 22, Monday: *Celebrate Mass this morning at St. Finbar’s* south before leaving Cork this morning and travelling east to the Crystal City of Waterford. The Waterford Crystal Factory showcases the expertise that goes into each delicate piece. Then onwards to the town of **Templemore and the Garda training college for a visit.** In the afternoon travel to the city of Dublin and take a short orientation tour before check-in to your hotel for overnight. Tonight explore some of Dublin’s pubs in the Temple Bar District and maybe the Ould Dubliner Bar, Keoghs and Gogartys to enjoy some traditional Irish music. Overnight in Dublin (B)
Oct. 23, Tuesday: This morning *celebrate Mass at St. Andrews* followed by an extensive tour of the city, taking in the Georgian Square, O’Connell Street and the Phoenix Park, Home to Garda Headquarters. From here travel to Trinity College for a visit to the famous Book of Kells, then visit the **National Garda Museum** before stopping at the Guinness Storehouse to round out your tour of Dublin. Return to your hotel with the remainder of the day free to explore the city on your own. Tonight there is a farewell celebration to enjoy traditional food and ‘Ceol agus Craic’ (music & fun). Overnight Dublin, (B,D)
Oct. 24, Wednesday: Transfer to Dublin airport and check in for your return flight to the USA.
